In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is suffering to provide extension of affiliation as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission/registrations/obtaining/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority, in the existing affiliation consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details submitted by school in regard to extension for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt. from time to time.
- The School is required to apply for extension for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
- The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per schedule III issued by District Education Officer (DEO)/equivalent officer.
- The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
- The school should go through the provisions of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and also advised to visit <http://cbse.nic.in> & <http://dhe.nic.in> for updates. The portal is updated to use it on 24/04/2019.
- The school will strictly adhere to all health and safety of students involving fire fighting and fire evacuation, fire fighting, action will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean, healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in appropriate and suitable for students. The school will ensure that fire, building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
- Admission to the school is to be restricted as per stipulated rules of Examination Bye Laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.4.6, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- The school is required to follow rule No. 2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding books and Quality of School.

- The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo, uniform or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of legal proceedings.
- The school must strictly provide supervision of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, saving of water, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc.
- The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. Affiliation-06/2019 dated 24.04.2019. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website [www.cbse.nic.in](http://www.cbse.nic.in).
- The optimum Section Teacher Ratio of 1:1 as well as student teacher ratio of 10:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- Every affiliated school shall submit regularly a completed and signed statement in District Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting of affiliation in a written request, usually first or second week of October, through web site to avoid the non-issuance of the certificates.
- Issuance of section certificate to the students is to be given only to the students who are appearing for the board examinations and is not permitted by the Board, if the school would be taken as defaulters.
- The Manager and the Principal of the school(s) are jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents, information/data submitted by the school to the Board.
- apart from rules to be followed by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to comply themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye Laws and circular/guide/notifications issued by the Board from time to time. - The School is required to abide strictly by the Examination and Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board.
- The School is required to apply for annual provisional affiliation application as required by and in accordance with the provisions of the preceding rule to effect the Provisional Affiliation system. Applications will be accepted after the last date along with the prescribed fee and late fee Rs. 10,000/- per month subject to a maximum of Rs. 40,000/-.
- Provisional Affiliation granted to a school will remain valid on receipt of valid application of a school for further extension of provisional affiliation subject to the final decision of the Board (Amended Rule 13.11).
- The school will retain its existing responsibilities as the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Provisional Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not be grossly reduced than the minimum number as under: From One Teacher to Class XII

As per Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 30 students.
  - e. The school is required to ensure that pay scales, DA and other admissible allowances are being paid either at par with the corresponding categories of employees working in the State Govt. Schools or as per 5th Pay Commission of Government of India and disburse the salary through ECS facility as per norms of the Board.
  - f. The School is required to furnish valid Sanitary Conditions, Safe Drinking Water, Fire Safety Certificates issued by the competent authority/concerned department.

5. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools

**Provisions of Affiliation bye laws for adherence:-**

1. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. **No capitation fee or voluntary donations** for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure i.a.w. rule no. 11.1, 2 & 3.
2. The school should not use the activities for **commercialization**:-
  - a) **As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)** It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.
  - b) **As per rule no. 19.1 (iii)** Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
3. Teachers are to be made educated regarding **corporal punishment** & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
4. School will not prepare any student/ start class for **any other Board** except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
5. **Admission to the school** is to be made restricted under rule 8.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.
6. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaska and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
7. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, **Service contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
8. **Pay and allowances** to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government. Further, **Salary and service conditions** of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-
  - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
  - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.

9. Continuous **sponsoring of students at board examination** is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv).
10. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
11. Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
12. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the '**Persons with Disabilities Act 1995**'.
13. **Health, sanitation and fire safety** should be adequately equipped i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (vii), rule 8.5 and rule 23.11.
14. **School infrastructure and teachers for examinations** conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
15. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own **website** containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos etc.
16. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least **one week training programme** for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
17. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
18. Strict adherence to the provisions of **Wild Life Protection Act** while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
19. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of **private publishers**. The content must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take appropriate action. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.
